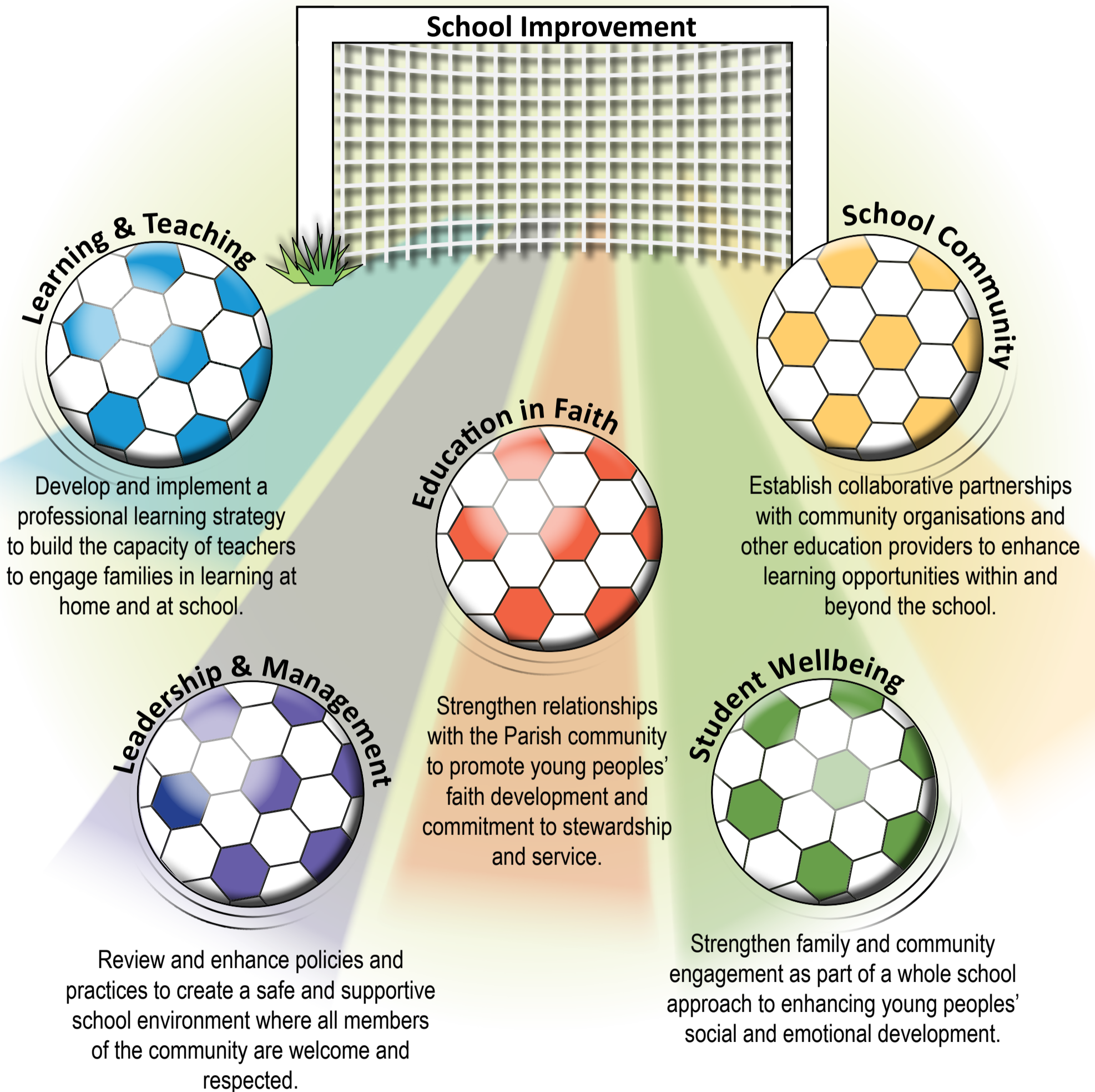




Family-school-community ties: Part of the main game
