TERMS & CONDITIONS

GOALS OF THE COMPETITION

- Create a designated shirt design for Catholic Education Student Protection Contacts to wear to highlight the everyday importance of safeguarding children and young people. This includes special events during the year, for example Child Protection Week.
- Assist students and staff to be aware of who the nominated Student Protection Contacts are within the school
- Encourage students, staff and parents to discuss what student protection means to them
- Offer students and staff an opportunity to work together to explore the theme of student protection

PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

All students in Catholic schools in the Diocese of Cairns are invited to participate. Entries must be original work and must not contain any copyrighted material or any intellectual property belonging to others, and not infringe on any third party right of privacy. This is including, but not limited to photographs, trademarks or logos.

CRITERIA FOR CREATIVE DESIGNS AND CONCEPTS

All entries must contain positive messages and images, submitted work must not contain any offensive or defamatory material or images.

It is expected that the final t-shirt design will be formed via four individual entries.

ENTRIES

Seeking concepts that students, staff and parents will find appealing and easily identify nominated staff as student protection contacts within the school setting. Only staff who have attended specialised Student Protection training will be gifted these shirts. This will not prevent schools from continuing to inform students that they can talk to any staff member if they have a concern or are worried about a peer.

There is no limit to the number of entries a student may submit, each entry must be clearly marked with an accompanying entry form.

The competition is open to individuals and groups of students who may wish to pool their creativity into one entry. If a group is placing an entry, please ensure all student names are included in or attached to the entry form.

DEADLINES

Competition design entries must be received by the school by Friday, 1 May 2020 so that they can be forwarded to Catholic Education Services for the judging process.

JUDGING PROCESS

A fair and impartial judging panel will judge the entries and select winners, based on creativity, design, originality. The decision of the panel is final, and no further discussion will be entered.

WINNING ENTRIES

Four winning entries will be chosen as a basis for the combined t-shirt design. Each winner will be invited to the official launch of 2020 Cairns Catholic Education Child Protection Week as special guests and be the first students to see the final design on the staff shirts.

PRIZES

Each winning entry will receive a \$250 JB HiFi gift voucher.
