



Public health rules continue

Physical distancing | 4m² per person indoors | Hand hygiene | Frequent environmental cleaning | Respiratory hygiene

Stage 1 March 2020

- Excursions and assemblies continue to be cancelled
- Essential workers only permitted access to school sites
- Management strategies developed for at risk staff
- Essential staff to restrict school visits to 1 school per day
- Meetings via Zoom
- [Level 1 sporting activities](#)

Stage 2 1 June 2020

- Excursions and overnight stays (not including camps) for groups of up to 20 (staff and students) may resume.*
- Essential staff may visit 2 schools per day.
- [Level 2 sporting restrictions.](#)
- Staff returning from outside of the region to follow state government advice.

Stage 3 10 July 2020

- [Level 3 sporting restrictions.](#) Inter school sporting activities (including contact sports**) involving up to 100 staff and students may resume.
- Assemblies of up to 100 people may occur, with physical distancing measures adhered to. Indoor assemblies must follow the 4m² rule.
- Excursions and overnight camps for groups of up to 100 (staff and students) may resume.***

*Excursions and sporting events will need COVID-19 plans that detail physical distancing, personal hygiene and environmental cleaning requirements.

** Contact sports will need to be planned to maximize physical distancing where practicable. For example, team football huddles would not be allowed.

*** Resumption of camps for school groups pending government advice.
