Colleen & Frank Sims Scholarships

Introduction

The Colleen & Frank Sims Scholarships are funded by generous support to the College by Mr Frank and Mrs Colleen Sims. The scholarships seek to offer places to students who will contribute to the richness and diversity of the College's community.

Criteria

- The scholarships are for new students entering Year 7 or Year 11
- The scholarship is awarded to students whose financial circumstances mean they would find it difficult to attend or complete their secondary education at Mount St Bernard College.

Process

- Applications should be received in the preceding year
- Applicants who are short listed, will be notified and asked to meet with the Principal for an interview.
- Applicants should ask their current principal to complete and submit directly to the school the 'MSB Scholarship Referee Report'
- All applications are handled confidentially due to the sensitive nature of financial circumstances that are involved for the applicants.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal.

Award

- The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant/s to 50% discount on tuition fees for their secondary education.
- Two scholarships are awarded per annum.
- An annual review of successful recipient/s will occur in December each year so that satisfactory progress is maintained.

Expectations

- The successful applicant/s are expected to uphold Mount St Bernard College expectations of being 'Safe, Respectful and Responsible'
- The successful applicant/s will be a role model regarding application and effort toward their learning
- The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.
