Principal's General Excellence Scholarship

Introduction

Mount St Bernard College offers General Excellence Scholarships annually to students entering Year 11. The scholarship program exists to foster diversity by ensuring that an education at Mount St Bernard College is available to as wide a range of students as possible. Our scholarship program seeks to offer places to students who will contribute to the richness and diversity of the College's community.

Criteria

- Applicants must be in Year 10 at the time of application.
- The scholarship is open to existing Mount St Bernard College students as well as students at other schools wishing to attend Mount St Bernard College for Years 11 & 12.
- The scholarship is awarded to a student who has an outstanding academic ability which is supported by a particular talent in an additional area.

Process

- Applications must be received by 1st December, of the preceding year to commencing senior studies.
- Applicants should ask their current principal to complete and submit directly to the school the 'MSB Scholarship Referee Report'
- Applicants who are short listed, will be notified and may be interviewed by a panel which comprises of Mount St Bernard College senior staff.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal. No award shall be made if, in the opinion of the Principal, no candidate is of sufficient merit.

Award

- The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant to 50% discount on tuition fees for two (2) years (Years 11 and 12).
- Two scholarships are awarded per annum.
- An annual review of successful recipient/s will occur in December each year so that satisfactory progress is maintained.
- The successful applicants will receive a framed certificate acknowledging this achievement.

Expectations

- The successful applicant/s are expected to uphold Mount St Bernard College expectations of being 'Safe, Respectful and Responsible'
- The successful applicant/s will be a role model regarding application and effort toward their learning
- The successful applicants will be asked to speak at a gathering as a scholarship recipient.
- The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.

- Any supporting documentation of any outside school commitment, *e.g. sporting clubs, music lessons, voluntary groups.*
- Written reference/s to support your application, *e.g. from a teacher, mentor or coach.*
- Letter from a parent or guardian to support their child's application and/or any special considerations you would like us to take into account.
- *If currently attending a school other than Mount St Bernard College and you have not already applied for enrolment, an Application for Enrolment form must accompany this scholarship application.
