St Andrew's Catholic College is a part of Diocese of Cairns System of 30 schools. Situated on a picturesque 25 ha site located in the Redlynch Valley, the College is a P-12 co-educational school of 1,720 students.

The College is organised into three sectors, all on the one site - Junior Years (Prep to Year 5); Middle Years (Year 6 to Year 9); and Senior Years (Year 10 to Year 12). In the Junior Years there are four classes per year level with 624 students in total.

In 2019, the College was recognised by the Global Forum for Education Learning as one of their top 50 organisations in Education – recognised at the Dubai conference.

The Principal administers this large College with the assistance of the *Deputy Principal – Head of Junior Years*, which is a key member of the College Senior Leadership Team.
