

Restricted Person

A restricted person is:

- A disqualified person
- A suspended blue or exemption card holder
- A negative notice holder
- A person who has been charged with a disqualifying offence and the matter has not yet been finalised
- The subject of an adverse interstate Working with Children Check decision that is in effect

NOTE

Changes to the Blue Card System – Queensland's working with children check commenced on Saturday, 20 September 2025.

These reforms are being made in response to recommendations from the Queensland Family and Child Commission and the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse. They are wide ranging and are designed to strengthen safeguards for children, streamline processes for individuals and businesses, and move towards a nationally consistent approach to working with children checks
