The following information will help you to frame a request to conduct research in Catholic Schools within the Diocese of Cairns.

All research conducted in our schools follows ethical approval process to ensure it aligns with our mission, supports educational excellence, and contributes positively to our communities. Research conducted by external researchers in our schools is approved by their institution's Human Research Ethics Committee and the CEDC Research Panel.

Researchers interested in conducting studies within CEDC are to complete the checklist and application form and email to: research@cns.catholic.edu.au

CEDC approval is not an endorsement of the research, but an indication to schools that the project is ethically sound and meets CEDC requirements as outlined in the Research Application Guidelines.

Researchers with CEDC approval can approach Catholic schools, but it is the principal's decision as to whether they agree for their school to participate in the research in any capacity.
